ADULT HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION \$500 SCHOLARSHIPS

PROGRAM GOAL:

To help women earn their adult high school diploma or GED® high school equivalency, empowering them to be able to seek employment or enroll in a postsecondary education program.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Any female Guam resident 18 years of age or older who wants to earn her adult high school diploma or GED®.

WAYS TO APPLY:

- 1.) Download the fillable pdf application form bwa.guam.gov and submit it along with a copy of a valid ID via email to info.bwa@guam.gov
- 2.) Obtain a printed copy at your mayor's office and submit it along with a copy of a valid ID either to the Bureau of Women's Affairs office at Adelup or at your mayor's office.

GCC ADULT HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA PROGRAM:

Register for GCC's Adult High School Diploma program and graduate **by May 9, 2024**. Upon proof of completion, BWA will present you with a \$500 scholarship check to help with your future endeavors.

GCC GED® HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY DIPLOMA:

BWA will pay the \$125 fee for scholarship recipients to take the GED® test and any re-take fees. The remainder of the \$500 scholarship will then be presented to the recipient in check form.
